



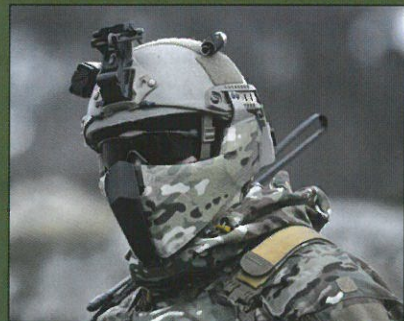
GLOMEX Military Supplies

Supplier of High-End Security Technologies and Services

Glomex Military Supplies is a purely Czech-capital company that has been supplying advanced defense technology since 1998, including equipment for special units, air force and armed and police forces. At the same time, it provides support in the field of training and maintenance, as well as technical and certification documentation – all that for the entire life cycle of the supplied equipment. Sales, technical, repair and training specialists from Glomex MS work with foreign manufacturers and developers from 12 countries around the world.

Products of the Company

Key technologies in the Glomex MS portfolio include night vision systems, combat identification systems, equipment for pilots, avionics and parachute systems. Glomex MS has its own technical, repair and storage facilities meeting the security requirements for classified equipment and advanced electronics, including night vision systems and specialized aircraft equipment. For example, the company carries out calibration of aviation test equipment and pre-flight inspection systems in its certified and authorized laboratory. It also has facilities and specialists to repair and maintain night vision systems and



ensures compatibility with dashboard lighting and aircraft and helicopter instruments. In addition, it also carries out repairs and maintenance of breathing apparatuses and high altitude kits for pilots and paratroopers. GLOMEX MS also offers equipment for artillery, ammunition for artillery and aircraft, including its testing and storage facilities,

armored vehicles including tanks, communications devices, engineering equipment, medical equipment, avionics, and other special equipment suitable for ground units of all levels, as well as an air force.

Projects and Cooperation with Partners

Glomex MS supplies its technologies and services to many important customers, including the Czech Army. At the end of 2015, the project providing Czech Air Force's C-295M aircraft crews with integrated sets of special equipment was successfully completed. Glomex MS, as a supplier of individual components and equipment, collaborated with the Air Force and Air Defence Military Technical Institute. Glomex MS, in line with the Air Force's requirements, has supplied the best and most suitable products from the world's leading manufacturers, ensuring their integration into a functional unit, including necessary tests and training of flight crews.

In the autumn of 2016, the Ministry of Defense of the Czech Republic signed a contract with Glomex MS for maintenance services for Airbus A319-115 (CJ) aircraft, belonging to the Czech Air Force. The general subcontractor of Glomex MS for this project is Lufthansa Technik, the world's largest aircraft maintenance provider. At the beginning of this year, Glomex MS received another important contract from the Ministry of Defense of the Czech Republic, which will provide maintenance support for Czech Air Force's Yakov-

lev Yak-40 Codling aircraft. As part of a tender issued by the Polish Air Force, the company placed a bid offering the Air Force a Boeing VIP transport airplane, including the provision of maintenance and support services.

Glomex MS supplies material, technology and services to armed forces across Central and Eastern Europe and CIS countries. Recently, these included Airborne Systems parachutes, Steiner's low-profile night vision devices, or safety helmets. In addition, the company is also working on projects with special police units in several countries.

Glomex MS cooperates with major US, British and German manufacturers of special equipment and technology for both ground and air forces. These include Steiner, Steiner



eOptics, Airborne Systems, Lufthansa Technik, Nightline, Ops Core, Gentex, Transaero, Coastal Environmental Systems, Zodiac Aerosafety Systems, Pennant, GPS Source, KMWEG, PSM, Survitec, Thermoteknix or IT & T. It has recently expanded its portfolio to include PepperBall products by United Tactical Systems. ■
